
Witam, Calafia!





Draft income right now is about \$3250 counting 250 site @\$8, 100 feast @\$12, 5 merchants @\$10. Will we get 250 or 100? We just had 90 at our Investiture but I do not know. I'm guessing – I need your advice on that – HELP. Of course, I have wiggle room in the feast budget. I'll tell them what they are going to spend and that is it! In advance I'll need site \$, and about \$600 feast advance. I'll float the rest of the feast expenses myself. That would get us through I think. The site check is due by June 1, 2010.
